Ohio Colt Racing Association

Eligibility:

For 2- and 3-year-olds in 2025 and must be sired by a stallion registered with the Ohio State Racing Commission.

To Be Raced At:

Circleville, Ottawa, Wilmington, Lebanon, Washington Court House, Sidney, Eaton, Wapakoneta, Xenia, Chillicothe, Urbana, Celina, Troy, Greenville, Lima, Findlay, Kenton, Dayton, Lancaster.

Payments:

March 15, 2025 (Nomination - Across-the-Board*)\$5	00
March 15, 2025 (Nomination - Individual Fair)\$	75
Starting Fee\$1	00

*Bonus: Nominate across the board in OCRA and select up to 3 fairs for that horse from the Southern Valley or Home Talent circuits for \$30 per fair which will be sent by the OCRA to the appropriate circuit. \$5 of each bonus fair fee will go to the Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium Scholarship which will be given in summer 2025.

Membership:

All owners of each entered colt or filly must be a member of the OCRA to make a nomination. \$35 is due for each registered owner when making the nomination payment by March 15, 2025.

Associate Membership:

For non-owners such as grooms, family members or friends of racing will be \$20.00 each. Each member and associate member will receive a membership card in May which will admit one person to the fairs on race day. This will be the universal pass for all circuits in the Buckeye Fair Racing Consortium (44 fairs).

Declarations:

Declarations to race closes 10:00 A.M. THREE (3) DAYS before the scheduled race, unless listed differently under each fair's conditions in the Huff's Guide. Two-year-olds must have at least one day off in between race days. No two-year-olds shall be permitted to race in more than one heat or dash in any single day. Starting any two-year-old in violation of this rule shall result in disqualification of the horse from the second day race, and all purse money earned shall be returned and redistributed.

Starting Fee:

\$100.00 payment payable day of race, even if the horse is scratched. In the event more than 8 horses are declared in to start, the race shall be divided and raced in divisions with no more than 2 trailers, each division race for an equal share of the total purse. The Judge may alter the division of the race, taking into consideration track safety. Each division will race only one heat. All races mile dashes. OSRC/USTA Rules to govern all races with exceptions.

Purse Distribution:

The purse for each race will be divided as follows:

Purse checks will be made payable only to the first programmed owner at declaration. That owner will be financially responsible for purse money and subsequent distribution to any other owners.

Trophies:

Will be awarded at the annual banquet to owners of colts and fillies winning the most points in each class based on the following system: Win-51, Second-26, Third-13, Fourth-9, Fifth-6 and all remaining starters-1. In the event of a dead-heat, as with purse money division, horses shall receive the standard distribution of points for their particular order of finish. Any pending appeal of a placing ruling issued by the judges shall not alter the point standing. OCRA driver and trainer awards will be based on the most wins in the circuit for the year.
